# Preamble

We, the People of the Pexi Tribe of the Kingdom Of Heaven, here in Mississippi State, pursuant to our inherent sovereignty, by the grace of Yah (God In Hebrew), in permitting us to form a more efficient and effective government, establish justice, ensure domestic tranquility, secure our rights, promote the general welfare, provide for continued tribal existence and fundamental governing principles, sustain our culture, and secure the natural and self-evident right to govern ourselves, to perform essential governmental functions, as defined in Article 3, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the Pexi Tribe of Mississippi.

# ARTICLE 1 – NAME, SOVEREIGNTY, & JURISDICTION

## **Section 1. Name**

The name of the tribal nation created by this Constitution shall be the Pexi Tribe. Other names Pexi Tribal Nation, Pexi Kingdom, And Pexi Tribal Kingdom.

## **Section 2. Sovereignty**

The aboriginal and inherent sovereign power of the Pexi Tribe is vested in the Pexi Tribal Chief is also the General, Divinity, and Sovereign with the assistance of the Tribal council and also the Pexi Tribesmen.

## **Section 3. Sovereign immunity**

The Pexi Tribe of Mississippi is immune from suit and the Tribal Chief/Divinity expresses its sovereign immunity.

#### **Section 4. Jurisdiction**

(a) The jurisdiction and governmental power of the Pexi Tribe of Mississippi extends to all individuals, persons, property, lands, both running waters, and lakes, airspace, all natural resources, both living and dead; all activities occurring within the exterior boundaries of the Pexi Tribe lands now so long as those lands are not within the boundaries of the reservation of another tribe; and;

(b) The Pexi Tribe of Mississippi shall also have jurisdiction over all other individuals, persons, property, resources, territory and subject matter to protect or exercise any rights and powers reserved and granted the Tribe.

# ARTICLE 2 – TRIBESMEN

## **Section 1. - Right To Determine**

The Pexi Tribal Nation has the right to determine who can become our tribesmen, in accordance with the Tribe's Constitution.

## **Section 2. - Eligibility**

A person shall be eligible to become our tribesmen, in the Pexi Tribe, if that person is living, applies for and meets the

following criteria:

- (a) All individuals/persons of Pexi Indigenous blood whose names appear on Pexi Bloodline Roll.
- (b) Must directly come from the Primogenitor as wrote on the Pexi Bloodline Life Roll. or
- (c) , must be a biological child of an enrolled Pexi Tribe, provided that such persons possess Pexi Tribe blood.
- (d) Any Indigenous person who is adopted in accordance with the acts and resolutions of the Tribal Council, provided however that an Indigenous adoptee shall not be eligible to hold an elected office and shall not share in any judgement fund or per capita payments otherwise available to enrolled Pexi tribal members pursuant to sub-sections (a) and (b) of this section. Indigenous adoptees shall have only those rights and privileges actually

bestowed by the Tribal Council at the time of adoption.

(e) All non-indigenous persons adopted as honorary members of the Pexi Indigenous Tribe. Non-Indigenous are restricted to the status of honorary citizenship and in no case shall an honorary citizen be entitled to hold an elected office, to vote or participate in any tribal affairs or share in any distribution of tribal funding reserved for enrolled Pexi Tribesmen pursuant to subsections (a),(b), And (c) of this section.

### **Section 3. Dual Enrollment is prohibited**

Any adult who has ever been a member of any other organized Tribe, band, or Indigenous community, officially recognized by the Secretary of the Interior, or not so recognized, shall not qualify to become our tribesmen.

All guests have no rights to be included within the government or to receive anything from the tribe outside of the agreements for labor and compensation for that labor. Also all guests can participate in our public events.

### **Section 4. - Relinquish**

Any Pexi Tribesmen may voluntarily relinquish their enrollment from the Pexi Tribe at any time pursuant to the enrollment laws of the Tribe. A Tribesman, 18 years or older, who voluntarily relinquishes their enrollment, in their own name, with the Pexi Tribe shall be prohibited from seeking re-enrollment as a member of the Pexi Tribesmen.



## **Section 5. - Revoked**

Being a Pexi Tribesmen, is a privilege that may be revoked by the Tribal Council for cause as determined by the acts and resolutions of the tribe. The Tribal Council may impose a penalty of full or partial banishment against any enrolled tribal member or citizen for good cause in accordance with Pexi Tribal tradition or the acts and resolutions of the tribe.

## **Section 6. - Approval or Denial**

The Tribal Council shall approve or deny all enrollment applications, based on criteria provided in the Constitution and laws of the Pexi Indigenous Tribe. The Pexi General Council shall be the final determinate, and have the power to make all final appeal decisions regarding citizenship, of who is or who is not a Pexi Tribesmen. Questions regarding membership are matters within the exclusive internal sovereignty of the Pexi Tribe and not justiciable in any court of law.

# ARTICLE 3 - GOVERNMENT,

## GENERAL COUNCIL, & GOVERNING BODY

### **Section 1. - Government**

The Pexi Tribe government is a Thearchy.

### **Section 2. - Thearch**

Our Thearch is the Universal creator of all things known and unknown, seen and unseen, Man and Woman. We called this Thearch Yah (The Creator In Hebrew).

### **Section 3. - Founder**

The founder and primogenitor name is El Leanko Pexi Yah

### **Section 4. - Tribal Chief/Divinity Immunity**

The Tribal Chief is also the, General, Divinity and Sovereign over the tribe. And

immune to all suits unless they break common law outside of the protection of the tribe and themselves.

## **Section 5. - Tribal Council Choosing**

The Tribal Council is picked out by the Tribal Chief/Divinity after they are tested and evaluated.

## **Section 6. - General Council**

The General Council is made up of all Pexi Tribesmen who reach the age of 18. They have the right to participate, and be picked for government positions.

# ARTICLE 4 - TRIBAL CHIEF/DIVINITY

## Section 1. - Tribal Chief/Divinity Selection

All Tribal Tribal Chief/Divinity Shall Be Chosen From The Tribal Divinity Private Selection System (TDPSS), Established By The Founder El Leanko Pexi Yah. The Founder Created A Private System To Ensure That A Worthy, Wise, And Righteous Tribal Chief/Divinity Is Always Chosen. All Children Of The Founder Or Tribesmen Who Reach Between The Age Of 25 - 40 May Be Able To Become Tribal Chief/Divinity.

- (a) All Potential Tribal Chief/Divinity Will Be Chosen By Tribal Divinity Private Selection System (TDPSS) Which Is A Independent Private Section Of The Tribe For The Specific Purpose To Choose Leaders.
- (b) The Process Of Picking The Next Tribal Chief/Divinity Is Private And Up To Tribal Divinity Private Selection System (TDPSS) To Choose The Right Leader After A Series Of Tests Based On The Test From The Founder.
- (c) All Tribal Chief/Divinity Are Subject To Removals As Well Under This Constitution Under The Removals For Tribal Divinity Section.
- (d) The Tribal Chief/Divinity Shall Approve Or Reject All Budgets, Laws, And Other Various Matters That Come From The Tribal Council.

# ARTICLE 5 - TRIBAL COUNCIL

## **Section 1. Tribal Council Selection**

The Tribal Council shall be picked by the Tribal Chief/Divinity, from the general council. All those picked by the Tribal Chief/Divinity must be skilled in their position or be trained to handle their position. The tribal council assists the Tribal Chief/Divinity in running and managing all the tribal affairs.

## **Section 2. Tribal Council Member Requirements**

All Tribal Council members must be 25 and older.

- (a) Must be a descendant of the Primogenitor.
- (b) Must be a member accepted as an official Pexi Tribesmen
- (c) Cannot be an outsider, guest, or honorary member.

## **Section 3. - The General Council**

There will always be 3 or more council tribesmen and they are chosen by the Tribal Chief/Divinity from the General Council.

- (a) Among the Tribal Council will be a foreign affairs department to deal with all foreign affairs and an attorney general to deal with all affairs pertaining to the name, image, likeness, and wisdom of the Pexi Tribe.

# ARTICLE 6 - TRIBAL

## ADMINISTRATORS

### **Section 1. - Tribal Administrators Selection And Requirements**

The Tribal Administrators are chosen by the Tribal Council And They Work On Behalf Of The Tribal Council. They Are Chosen From The Tribesmen Who Have Reached The Age Of 21.

- (a) Administrate all the working affairs of the tribe.
- (b) Over all the laborers and assist the laborers in carrying out tasks for the tribe.
- (c) Carry out all tasks required from the Tribal Chief/Divinity & tribal council.

# ARTICLE 7 - TRIBAL LABORERS

## **Section 1. - Tribal Laborer Requirements**

All laborers are under the tribal administrators and help assist the tribal administrators to run all government and all labor and everything that the tribes require.

- (a) All tribesmen at the age of 16 can become a laborer and require the proper assistance in becoming one.
- (b) Honorary members and guests can also become tribal laborers. For The rules and laws, The Tribal council will have the final say so.
- (c) The Tribal Courts Shall Establish Labor laws to ensure that all laborers are treated fairly and with honor.



# ARTICLE 8 - TRIBAL LAW &

## COURTS

### **Section 1. - Tribal Courts Requirements**

The Tribal Courts shall be presided over by the Tribal Justice and the tribal laws shall be administered by the head justice. There will also be Tribal judges who assist the Tribal Justice in running the tribal courts and the tribal laws.

(a) There will always be a main Tribal Justice. Pick by the Tribal Chief/Divinity.

(b) There will always be a main Tribal Judge Of the Executive Department. The Executive Branch is responsible for carrying out the laws of the Tribes.

(c) There will always be a main Tribal Judge Of the Judicial Department. The Judicial Branch is responsible for interpreting the laws of the Tribes.

(d) There will always be a main Tribal Judge Of the Legislative Department. The Legislative Branch is responsible for making the laws of the Tribes.

### **Section 2. - Tribal Labor Laws**

The Tribal Courts Shall pass labor laws to help tribal administrators and tribal laborers and to assist them in carrying out all the functions of the tribe under the authority of the Tribal Chief/Divinity who have the final say.

# ARTICLE 9 - RECALL, REMOVALS, AND TERMINATIONS

## **Section 1. - Check And Balances**

There is a balance of power and a series of checks and balances to keep a check on all governmental power. In this section we will layout all details that can get

- (a) - A recall is someone who has been dismissed in any form from their position for a period of time.
- (b) - A removal is anyone who has violated their position of office but did not betray the tribe. They are removed from their position and status. They can be recalled after careful consideration from the Tribal Chief/Divinity or tribal council.
- (c) - A termination is for traitors or those who betray the tribe or harm any tribesmen.

## **Section 2. - Tribal Chief/Divinity Checks And Balances**

The Tribal Chief is also the General, Divinity, And Sovereign over the tribe. But he can be removed and replaced by failing to uphold

- (a) - Protecting the tribe and tribesmen. Harming or letting harm befall on the tribe and not dealing with it shows incompetence and lack of understanding.

(b) - Working with outside forces against the tribe.

(c) - Mismanagement of the tribe

(d) - Not upholding the founder mandate.

### **Section 3. - Breaking Oaths And Affirmations**

All other government positions are under oaths and affirmations. If they don't uphold their oath of office. The termination laws are enacted.

# ARTICLE 10 - TRIBAL COMMERCIAL

## CODE

### **Section 1. Commercial Dealings**

The Tribal Commercial Code is for the sale of all businesses, estates, and other items that are sold, bought, traded, or bartered with other nations and within our own nation.

(a) Charters & Trusts

(b) Gold, Silver, Negotiable Instruments, Bitcoin & Other Currencies

(c) Tribal Associations/Corporations

(d) And Other Commercial Items.

# ARTICLE 11 - FOREIGN AFFAIRS

## **Section 1. - Establishment**

The Tribal Chief/Divinity And Council shall also establish a foreign affairs section. They deal with all foreign affairs with other kingdoms, nations, tribes, groups, communities, and other governments.

(a) Only pick from the tribal council members who are trained and well versed in the languages of foreign relations.

# ARTICLE 12 - TRIBAL ANCESTORS &

## ELDERS

### Section 1. Requirements And Honors

The Ancestors' Palace shall be made into two parts. The Ancestors And The Elders. The Ancestors palace is the highest honor of the tribe.

- (a) Ancestor Palace - Is for all those tribesmen who have put forth their best effort for the tribe and made great progress for the growth and well being for the tribe that have passed on. We honor our ancestors that made sure we are safe and loved.
- (b) The Elders Abode - Is for all those tribesmen who are alive and don't work in the government anymore or for the tribe anymore. The elder abode is for the tribesmen who are still alive and still want to be useful.
- (c) They can be recalled into the government if there isn't anyone useful within the general council, an immediate death within the government and, if, the Tribal Thamorian recalls an Elder for a temporary acceptance of a position.
- (D) The Elders Will Also Be In Charge Of The Attainments Order System Hall (AOS Hall). This System Is For Tribesmen Who Excelled At Their Craft, Knowledge, Or Field Of Study. For Recognition Of The Efforts And Rewards

# Article 13 - Pexi Guard

## Section 1 - The National Guard Role

- (1) - The Tribal Chief/Divinity Shall Be The Head General Over The Entire National Guard Of The Pexi Tribe.
- (2) The Pexi Guard Goals Is For The Self Defense Of The Tribesmen At Home Or Abroad.
- (3) Eligible Tribesmen Who Are Of 18 Years Of Age And Who Complete The Basic Guardsmen's Training Will Be Accepted For Roles Within The National Guard.
- (4) The Tribal Chief/Divinity Shall Choose From The Tribal Council A Righteous Commander And Who Is Over The Pexi Guard After The General.
- (5) The Commander Shall Be Over The Proceedings On How The Pexi Guard Is Ran Outside Of The Tribal Chief/Divinity And The Tribal Council.
- (6) All Guardsmen Will Be Subject To The Jurisdiction Of Military Courts Which Will Be Upheld By A Special Military Judge Chosen By Tribal Chief/Divinity And The Tribal Council.
- (7) The Military Courts Will Also Be Under The Rules Of The Tribal Courts And Administered By The Head Justice.
- (8) All Guardsmen Are To Be Compensated And All Guardsmen Who Became Elders Are Given Extra Pensions For Their Role In Protecting The Tribe.
- (9) All Guardsmen Who Die During Active Duty Are To Be Given The Full Honor And Their Families Are To Be Given A Pension For Their Service To Protecting The Tribe. Including Those Who Are Injured.
- (10) Guardsmen Who Betray Their Duties And Tribe Are To Be Terminated And Given The a Traitor Status.



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
